NOTICE OF RESOLUTION DENYING REQUEST FOR RECONSIDERATION
Completion of Academic Building III (Laboratory Building) Phase IV

In view of your Request for Reconsideration of your Disqualification which this committee received on August 29, 2017, please be informed that, after careful deliberation and thorough discussion, with regrets, the Committee hereby resolved to **DENY** your **REQUEST** for **RECONSIDERATION**.

The primary concern in bid evaluation and post-qualification is to review all pertinent documents submitted for the project to be bid. SNBC, having submitted the lowest calculated bid should be subjected to these stages of the procurement process to verify its performance in its previous projects and the veracity of the documents submitted.

While it is true that SNBC was declared eligible by the committee during its eligibility check, the Procuring Entity thru the committee, has the right to *review the qualifications of the bidder at any stage of the procurement process*”, as provided for in Section 23.6 of the IRR of RA 9184.

This committee duly noted that the projects of SNBC with CTU which is the construction of the **Center for Studies in Biodiversity** (has -5% slippage) and with **DPWH** which is the construction of **Pangan-an ES, Lapu Lapu City** (has -30% slippage) have respective contract price that is less than 50% of the ABC of the project under bidding, BUT, these are **ONGOING** projects that needed to be declared in the statement of all ongoing government and private contracts which is required as per Section 23.1. Site visits conducted on August 17, 2017 by the TWG of this committee uncovered that these are on-going projects of SNBC.

Furthermore, the -30% slippage incurred by SNBC with the DPWH project, **Pangan-an ES, Lapu Lapu City** is a ground for disqualification as per Section 34.

Section 25.2b(iii) of the IRR of RA 9184 latest edition, requires the disclosure of all ongoing government and private contracts. Non-disclosure of the above mentioned projects is a ground for disqualification in accordance with Rules XXI, XXII and XXIII of the IRR.

Lastly, the non-disclosure that the committee is referring to is not pertaining to relationships as embodied in the Omnibus Sworn Statement. The non-disclosure that the committee refers to is failure of SNBC to declare all of its on-going government and private contracts.

Premises considered, Motion for Reconsideration is hereby DENIED.


